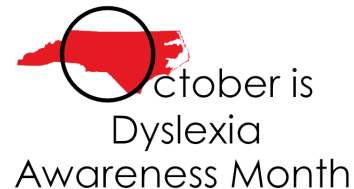


Dyslexia Awareness Month Jacksonville Events & More
