*History and Science of Effective Interventions for Students with Dyslexia*

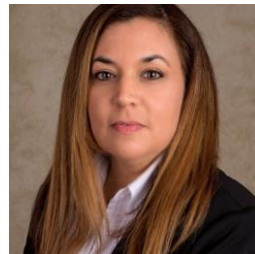
